

About the Theme

This retreat will walk down Memory Lane to the early days of our "being a Catholic" and look at some of the positives and negatives of that time and the effects they still have on us today. From there, we will listen to some of the prophets of the 20th and 21st centuries and see what challenges they have put before us. Then we will ask ourselves how these challenges can be met in a fast-paced, ever-changing world where an evolutionary world view is essential for survival.

Bring with you a creative imagination, a readiness to share ideas and a joke to tell, a song to sing, an instrument to play or two hands to clap when others entertain. For the weekend, in the special place that is Maryknoll, we will form community as we search together for the Great Mystery.

About Our Presenter

Mary Anne Muller was born into a large family in Brooklyn, New York, which has been made larger by the addition of four children and ten grandchildren, the great joy of her life. She attended Bishop McDonnell High School and St. John's University where she now works. She teaches mainly Moral Theology of the Marketplace and Theology of Peace.

Mary Anne spent twenty-four years as Pastoral Associate in St. Vincent Ferrer Church in Brooklyn. With Fr. Coman Brady, she tried to build a Peace Church where parishioners took a vow of non-violence each year and where it was an open house to peace groups from around the world. She served as Chairperson of PCMNY's Steering Committee in the early 2000s and still belongs to the now small Pax Christi group started there. She is also happy to be a member of the Kairos Community.

In 2017, Mary Anne received PCMNY's Sister Christine Mulready Peacemaker Award, which recognized her dedication to care for God's creation as a priority in her life, a responsibility, and a moral and ethical mandate of our faith. In addition, she is known for her service to Catholic Worker, her public witness, and her overall commitment to be peace, teach peace, and make peace.

Cost: *Please make every effort to join us for the whole weekend.* It is the best and most fruitful way to benefit from the retreat experience. The fee for the whole retreat, including *five meals and two overnight stays*, is \$250. The fee for commuters, including *five meals but no housing*, is \$220. If you can only come on Saturday, the fee, including *three meals*, is \$125. A \$50 non-refundable deposit must accompany registration. Registration will be on a first-come, first-serve basis through February 16th. Limited scholarships may be available. Please call PCMNY for more information.
