

# "43rd Annual Good Friday Way of the Cross"

Join several hundred people in one of the largest public Christian witnesses for peace in New York City. In this, our 43rd year, Pax Christi Metro New York will commemorate Good Friday as a modern-day enactment of the Stations of the Cross, praying for peace and justice on the streets of our city.

We remember that throughout our lives, Jesus calls us to active non-violence. This year our theme is, *"In a time of polarization and conflict, how do we follow the path of Jesus?"*

The walk will take place in person, from 8:30 a.m. to 12 p.m., on Good Friday, April 18, 2025. We begin at Dag Hammarskjöld Plaza (East 47th Street at 1st Avenue) and proceed along 42nd Street to between 8th and 9th Avenues.
